An update on the Baird Road project: No definitive decision has been reached as of press time. We have been told that the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency has tax credit financing funds for fewer than 15% of the 89 projects submitted for consideration. At this point it has not been reported which projects will be funded. Final selections will be made no later than the LHFA October meeting. The outcome is to be posted on their website.
